- Manage and execute ordering writing for seasonal and core assortment.
- Analyze retail core assortment productivity to identify opportunities to refine sku offering.
- Develop seasonal sku plan to optimize sku productivity.
- Maintain size scale analysis.
- Optimize in season inventory levels for core assortment through executing transfers.
- Maintain and communicate adjustments to import plan.
